

THANK YOU FOR HELPING TO KEEP RIFLE'S STREETS SAFE AND CLEAN.

This is a friendly reminder that Rifle Municipal Code states that;

Repairing, greasing, painting, or washing a vehicle on public property is prohibited.

Leaving any inoperable vehicle on any public property within the city is prohibited.

Inoperable vehicles are defined as;

- Unlicensed (expired plates or no plates/registration)
- Partially dismantled or wrecked
- Placement of the vehicle upon jacks, or other supports
- Absence of one or more parts which are necessary for lawful operation upon streets and highways

Abandoning a vehicle on public property is prohibited. Vehicles deemed abandoned on public property are defined as;

- **Any vehicle left in the same place on public property for more than 72 hours**
