## Temporary Structure During Home Construction

For a more detailed interpretation, please refer to the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions of Grass Mesa.

<u>Temporary Structure</u>: No structure of a temporary nature such as an RV, tent, travel trailer, garage, barn, or other outbuilding or basement shall be used upon any Lot as a residence, either temporarily or permanently; provided, however, an RV or travel trailer shall be permitted on a Lot during construction of a permanent residence thereon for a period not to exceed one year. RV's and travel trailers may be utilized for residential purposes on any Lot for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days in any twelve-month (calendar year) period, except during the construction of a permanent residence and for only one year.
